General Safety Information for Paragolfer User

The Paragolfer is a single person all-terrain special mobility device that lifts people from a sitting position to a standing position for the purpose of playing golf. It is designed solely for persons who are unable to walk or have a walking impediment while doing physically activity that requires them to maintain an upright body position. The ParaGolfer was specially designed for users who are able to independently move in a sports wheelchair.



The product allows for fast and easy adjustment of seat depth and lower leg length. It enables the operator to achieve an upright posture, with unrestricted shoulder movement when swinging a golf club.

This freedom is not only a huge benefit on the golf course; it also opens up new possibilities of movement during a range of other activities. The functions enable users of a range of mobility impairments and conditions including (but not limited to):

- Paraplegia
- Spina bifida
- Cerebral paresis
- Multiple sclerosis
- Muscular dystrophy
- Polio

The Paragolfer is available for hire to play rounds and to practice on the driving range. To use the Paragolfer the following safety requirements apply. You will need to:

- Provide a Medical Certificate and completed Health Disclosure checklist once per year.

- Undergo an operator and safety brief and simple competency test by Moore Park Golf, or their representative
- Playing Play accompanied with another person or carer at all times
- Driving range play accompanied with another person or carer at all times
- Driving range Use of the Auto Tee on the driving range and be unaccompanied following a simple competency test by Moore Park Golf, or their representative
